By subscription of \$500 each which should accompany the nomination; \$3,000 to pass the entry box and an additional \$4,500 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$7,500 (along with the entry and starting fees) must be made before 11:00 AM Saturday June 27th. The guaranteed purse will be divided accordingly, \$275,000 to the owner of the winner, \$100,000 to second, \$60,000 to third, \$30,000 to fourth, \$15,000 to fifth, \$10,000 to sixth and the remaining \$10,000 divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. Trophies will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, June 20, 2015 with 18 Nominations. (Clear 75)

EFFINEX allowed to settle saving ground as the field strung out early on, advanced in tandem with the rest with five furlongs to go as the duelers caught a breather steadying briefly with nine-sixteenths to go off the heels of STREET BABE, came under coaxing just past the five-sixteenths just off the inside and swung three wide for home, rallied steadily wearing down the leader in the final eighth joined to the outside by TONALIST, dug in seizing command inside the sixteenth marker knocking heads to the end and denied that foe on the wire in game fashion. TONALIST four wide early on, took to the three path with six furlongs to go briefly before the field advanced in tandem on the duelers with a rush five furlongs out, shifted his way back to the four path nudging MYLUTE five wide at that station, raced four wide in the turn patiently handled until nearing the quarter pole, got roused four wide into upper stretch, rallied outside a pair to get latched on nearing the sixteenth marker fighting head to head through to the finish with EFFINEX but was ultimately denied in a good effort. COACH INGE dueled from the three path with STREET BABE to his inside spurting away from the rest in tandem through the first turn into the backside, took a collective breather with his pace rival through the latter portion of the backside and had the field advance quickly with five furlongs remaining, shook off STREET BABE with half a mile to go and tucked to the two path put to a light coaxing, spun just off the inside for home roused into upper stretch, dug in holding well and stubborn under challenge through the final eighth, got caught just inside the sixteenth marker and was along well clear for the show honors. NECK 'N NECK four wide early on, tucked to the three path three furlongs from home and gradually continued inside to spin just off the inside into upper stretch let out for the drive, then tired in the lane. MYLUTE chased the pace four wide, got nudged five wide with nine-sixteenths to go as TONALIST made some room after the field advanced on the duelers, came under coaxing three furlongs from home, spun three wide into upper stretch and faltered. STREET BABE gape dueled with COACH INGE to his outside through a swift opening quarter before taking a breather in tandem with his main rival through the latter portion of the backside, had the field advanced and came under coaxing at the nine-sixteenths, got shaken off into the far turn and retreated steadily thereafter.
