SONGBIRD stalked the pace off the rail, bid outside the runner-up on the backstretch, put a head in front just past midway on the backstretch, inched away a bit off the rail on the second turn and drew off in the stretch under a long loose rein. BELLAMENTARY sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, duelled along the rail on the backstretch, had the winner slip away on the second turn, came out a bit into the stretch and just held second. KAY KAY stalked outside a rival then three deep on the second turn and into the stretch and was edged for the place. THAT'S A LADY saved ground chasing the pace, went between horses on the second turn and into the stretch and weakened. SUTTON'S SMILE stalked the pace off the rail then inside on the second turn and weakened in the drive.
