TRAINEE advanced inside after a half, got through along the rail to challenge for and gain a short lead after five furlongs then continued well past the furlong marker but was no match for the winner late while best of the rest. SAINT BARBARA raced close up early, bid four wide after five furlongs then weakened in the final furlong. MISS TIZZYNOW pressed the issue early, bid three wide after five furlongs but also gave way in the drive. S P INDY angled out five wide into the stretch but had no response. MY GOLDEN QUEST was hung five wide to the second turn then faded. ALARMING ANYTIME set a moderate pace for five furlongs then gave way. TALE OF THE QUEEN was hung six wide to the second turn then stopped. RUNWAY QUEEN trailed.
