Bay Colt, (Feb), by Runaway Groom - Hasty Appeal by World Appeal. Trainer Machowsky Michael. Bred by Luis de Hechavarria(FL).

KELLY LEAK rated toward the outside, steadily advanced four wide once on the backstretch to take over at the head of the lane, gradually lugged in under a drive, was kept to task to the wire and held off MYTHICAL POWER. The latter raced in contention between rivals from the beginning, two and three wide taking the second bend, rallied belatedly the last furlong, took over second inside the sixteenth marker and was getting to KELLY LEAK late. SCOREWITHCATER in midpack early, closed the gap just off the inside on the backstretch, angled out five wide on the second turn, lost ground that wide entering the stretch, found best stride too late but caught MINE THAT BIRD for third near the wire.

MINE THAT BIRD progressed from outside to vie for the lead four wide on the second turn, angled in some as he gained a narrow advantage between rivals leaving that bend, was no match for KELLY LEAK when set down for the drive, battled to keep second but did not have enough left. ADVICE was checked back from crowding after the break, settled not far off the inside, brushed with INFERNAL as he picked up his pace into the second turn, was three wide entering the lane, altered out trying to gain a clear path nearing the eighth pole, was soon blocked again, altered in some inside the last furlong and made up minor ground. DUMAR forced in after the start, was settled inside, commenced his bid going to the second turn, came off the rail some early in that bend, was checked behind the fading MAYOR MARV after leaving the quarter pole, fanned four wide for the stretch run, altered out to avoid ADVICE upper stretch and was closing the gap through the waning yards. MARK S THE COOLER was bumped and forced into INFERNAL at the start then jostled with that one briefly, advanced from outside on the backstretch, angled in three wide on the second turn, lost ground fanning to path six for the drive then lacked the needed bid.

SANTAMONICACANYON drifted out some into the first turn, contested the pace from paths two or three, moved to the rail leaving the second turn and flattened out the final furlong. INFERNAL jostled briefly with MARK S THE COOLER just after the start, was altered in some, showed no speed from outside, brushed with ADVICE into the second turn, improved position four wide, fanned out to path six for the stretch run and was empty. SMOKIN' LEGEND broke inward, bumping MARK S THE COOLER, backed up from outside going to the half mile mark, swung in then back to the outside early in the second turn, was in the middle of the track for the stretch run and had little left. MAYOR MARV angled in after the start, causing crowding to the those inside, disputed the pace between rivals to the second bend then gave way and was allowed to coast through the lane. VALID STRIPES displayed early speed inside, quit into the second turn, drifted out to the middle of the track for the drive and was in hand the rest of the way.
