RUNAWAY DANCER angled in on the first turn and settled inside, moved up along the rail on the final turn, came out in upper stretch, split rivals in the drive to gain the lead past midstretch, kicked clear under some urging, drifted in and proved best. FITZ FLAG (ARG) settled inside or a bit off the rail, came out on the last turn and four wide into the stretch and gained the place. SPRING HOUSE saved ground off the pace, came out into the backstretch, went between foes then bid three deep on the final turn, took the lead into the stretch, battled outside rivals then between horses past midstretch and just held third. RUSH RUSH chased outside a rival then three deep on the backstretch, continued outside on the last turn, came out some in the stretch and was edged for the show. STORMIN AWAY pulled a bit early, chased outside a rival or a bit off the rail, bid between horses on the final turn and until past midstretch and weakened late. BRIGHT PREDICTION pulled his way to a clear early lead, opened a lengthy advantage in the stretch the first time, fought back inside on the last turn and to midstretch and weakened in the final furlong.
