7 FURLONGS. (1:20) STAKES. Purse \$150,000 Swale S. (Grade III) THREE YEAR OLDS. Free nomination by Sunday, January 20. \$1,500 to enter. \$150,000 Guaranteed. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing sixth through last, 62% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, and 3% to fifth. Weight: 122 lbs. Non-winners of a graded stakes allowed 2 lbs.; a stakes race, 4 lbs.; two races other than maiden, claiming, or starter, 6 lbs. Starters to be named by usual time of closing. Supplemental nominations may be made at time of entry. All fees shall be paid prior to the start of the race. This race will be limited to 14 starters, with also eligibles. Preference will be given to graded stakes winners, then by highest career earnings. Trophy to the winning owner. (Cloudy 78)

CALL PAUL brushed the left side of the gate to get away flat-footed, recovered to head up the second flight after a quarter-mile, began moving after the leaders four wide five-sixteenths out, reached the front outside HIGH CRIME and ZENDEN under a drive through midstretch, and was shown the whip clear through the last 70 yards. ZENDEN stalked from close range outside the leaders, bid three wide between horses a quarter-mile out, could not match strides with the top one entering the last furlong on the wrong lead, but gamely held clear of the others. TOPPER T lost his footing badly at the start and bumped with JACKSON once into stride, checked behind FROSTED GRACE near the seven-eighths pole, saved ground advancing a bit to the turn, moved out three wide near the quarter-pole, shifted out further and gained late on the far outside. HIGH CRIME pressed the pace outside COUNTRY SINGER, bid two wide between rivals late on the turn, and weakened past the furlong marker. FROSTED GRACE moved off the inside in front of TOPPER T near the seven-eighths, tracked the leaders near the two-path, was steered outside in midstretch, and could not gain while lugging in late. SEISMIC JOLT bumped hard with CHINOMADO at the start, raced far back widest up the backstretch, took the turn three wide and made little headway. CHINOMADO bumped hard with SEISMIC JOLT at the start, and was outrun toward the inside. HARD BELLE bumped with COUNTRY SINGER at the start, and was always outrun. TAKE COMMAND was no factor two wide. COUNTRY SINGER bumped with HARD BELLE at the start, dashed out to set a sharp pace, and gave way to a plethora of challengers through upper stretch. JACKSON broke slowly, then bumped with TOPPER T after a few strides, and trailed throughout.
