Closed with 8. All horses (including supplements) to pay \$2,250 additional to start, with \$150,000 guaranteed. of which \$90,000 to the winner, \$30,000 to second, \$18,000 to third, \$9,000 to fourth and \$3,000 to fifth. Weight 124 lbs. Winners of \$250,000 at a mile or over three times in 2011, 2 lbs additional. Non-winners of two such races in 2011 allowed 2 lbs. Such a race in 2011 4 lbs. Such a race of \$100,000 in 2010-2011 allowed 6 lbs. Such a race of \$50,000 in 2010-2011 allowed 8 lbs. Non-winners of two races other than maiden or claiming allowed 10 lbs, such a race allowed 12 lbs. A Trophy will be presented to the winning owner. (Clear 80)

DREAMY KID a half step slow to begin, angled in on the first turn then chased just off the rail, split horses into the stretch, came out some in the drive and rallied under urging to get up on the wire. COIL pulled hard under a hold forcing the pace outside RUNFLATOUT, was floated out slightly into the stretch, took a short lead nearing midstretch, inched away nearing the sixteenth pole and held on well but was caught in the final stride. UNCLE SAM close up stalking the pace outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch and bested the others. RUNFLATOUT a half step slow to begin, tugged a bit and went up inside to the early lead, set a pressured pace along the rail, fought back when headed but weakened in the final sixteenth. SPUD SPIVENS saved ground stalking the pace, fell back some in midstretch and weakened.
