DIRT: Non-winners of a Graded Sweepstake over a mile on the dirt in 2005-06 allowed 3 lbs.; A sweepstake over a mile on the dirt in 2005-06, 5 lbs. In the event that this race is taken off the turf, it may be subject to downgrading upon review by the Graded Stakes Committee.

Chestnut Horse, (Jan), by Deputy Minister - Partygoer by Secretariat. Trainer Pletcher A. Todd. Bred by Wertheimer & Frere(KY).

GO DEPUTY steadied between horses on the first turn, settled near the back of the pack for six furlongs, gradually gained from outside on the far turn, rapidly closed the gap while four wide to threaten on the turn, accelerated to the front from outside in upper stretch then edged clear under steady urging. SILVER WHISTLE was taken in hand while saving ground for a mile, swung out to launch his bid midway on the turn, circled five wide advancing into the stretch and finished strongly in the middle of the course to best the others. GRAND COUTURIER (GB) was taken in hand along the inside in the early stages, raced just off the pace between horses along the backstretch, worked his way forward to challenge on the turn, raced in traffic between horses in upper stretch, steadied in tight while lacking room nearing the furlong marker and continued on willingly to gain a share. RAMAZUTTI battled heads apart through the opening half mile, took the lead along the backstretch, set the pace along the inside to the turn, relinquished the lead to the winner in upper stretch and weakened from his early efforts. RELAXED GESTURE (IRE) took the lead soon after the start, set the pace for a half mile, was taken under a firm hold while being eased back leaving the wire the first turn, raced between horses while well in hand for a mile, launched a bid midway on the turn, swung four wide between horses at the quarter pole then lacked the needed response when called upon. SILVERFOOT was rated well back for a mile while saving ground, angled four wide on the turn and lacked a strong closing bid. CROWN POINT raced up close between horses along the backstretch, angled to the inside on the turn, lodged a mild bid while saving ground into the stretch, steadied while lacking room in midstretch and failed to threaten thereafter. WILD DESERT failed to mount a serious rally while wide throughout.
