MAIN SEQUENCE off three beats slow after hip checking the left of the starting gate, recovered and joined up with the others soon afterwards, sat well reserved in the two path, picked up interest heading for the top of the lane, spun four wide into the stretch and took off in earnest after the front runners, arrived at the eighth pole full of run, whittled away at the advantage, collared IMAGINING with a couple of jumps to spare before reaching the finish line. IMAGINING vied for the lead from the two path during the initial stages, shook free nearing the second turn and was placed closer to the rail, set the pace, rating kindly and with TWILIGHT ECLIPSE in close attendance to the outside, got challenged by that revved-up rival approaching the quarter pole, was allowed to settle into upper stretch before getting called upon, dug in with good determination before reluctantly relinquishing to the top one in the shadow of the wire. TWILIGHT ECLIPSE stalked the front runners from the two path for the opening half, moved up to become the primary pursuer once the runner up had assumed control, kept pace down the backstretch and around the final turn as well, got put to a drive and issued a challenge as the field headed into the stretch, wasn't able to go by, but continued onward in a willing manner to secure the show. WAR DANCER stalked the leader from the two path, picked up the pace when asked for run in the vicinity of the three-eighths pole, came three wide into the stretch, flattened out. AMIRA'S PRINCE (IRE) saved ground to the quarter pole, made no headway after getting angled outward for the stretch drive, then was vanned off after the finish. O'PRADO OLE contended for the lead from the inside for a half, was allowed to ease back into the pocket midway along the homestretch, got put to a drive by the five-sixteenths marker, tired. PERFECT TIMBER saved ground throughout, failed to respond when asked to midway around the final turn.
