Chestnut Colt, (Mar), by Kitten's Joy - Dynaire by Dynaformer. Trainer Thomas Albertrani. Bred by Woodslane Farm, LLC. (KY).
SADLER'S JOY broke a beat slow and struck the off side stall leaving the gate, settled inside through the first turn before taking up cover behind HUNTER O'RILEY in the two path, remained on hold through to nearing the quarter pole, angled out six wide at that station set down for the drive, rallied with a good kick to issue challenge through the final sixteenth surging late to overthrow the top pair in the last jumps and get up at the wire. MONEY MULTIPLIER coaxed from the gate briefly, settled just off the inside through the first turn before taking to the three path in the clear in mid pack first time past the stands, tucked back to the two path taking up cover behind ERUPT when BIGGER PICTURE took the cover behind FRANK CONVERSATION the initial time past the wire, remained rated in mid pack until lightly coaxed nearing the quarter pole, swung six wide into upper stretch let out for the drive, rallied with good energy to hook up head to head with BIGGER PICTURE inside the eighth pole, knocked heads to the finish taking a slim advantage inside the sixteenth marker when overthrown by the aforementioned foe in tandem with his dueling partner and was forced to settle for the place honors. BIGGER PICTURE tracked the pace from the two path in behind the cover of ERUPT, took to the inside the initial time past the finish post taking up behind the cover of FRANK CONVERSATION in the pocket, remained on hold until nearing the half mile pole, tipped out three wide into the clear, came under light coaxing with seven-sixteenths to go, angled five wide into upper stretch let out for the drive, rallied to take command just inside the eighth pole confronted by the aforementioned rival to the outside, dug in knocking heads through to the finish clinging to the front until inside the sixteenth marker, then was nailed in tandem by SADLER'S JOY in the final jumps and forced to settle for the show honors. HUNTER O'RILEY just off the inside near the rear, was in behind the cover of BIGGER PICTURE until that rival went to the inside, then settled using the cover of MONEY MULTIPLIER while in hand, remained so until put to coaxing with three furlongs remaining, angled out five wide into upper stretch following BIGGER PICTURE, offered up a mild kick but was outkicked to the wire. ERUPT (IRE) a bit keen under restraint tossing his head at times just off the inside behind the cover of IDAHO, settled better once established down the backstretch, came under light coaxing nearing the quarter pole, swung four wide at that station fully extended, failed to quicken through the stretch. IDAHO (IRE) a bit washy, attended the pace of FRANK CONVERSATION from the two path in hand at times trading the front while applying little pressure save his presence, came under coaxing with five-sixteenths to go as the pace quickened, angled three wide at the head of the stretch, fought head to head with the leader to the eighth pole, got overhauled inside that station and weakened in the late stages. FRANK CONVERSATION established the front and showed the way in hand along the hedge while under the watchful eye of IDAHO to the outside under little pressure save that rival's presence until past the three-eighths, came under increasing prompting to the outside and was put to coaxing with five-sixteenths to run, spun just off the inside into upper stretch under threat as his escort loomed to the outside, dug in under growing pressure from a host, succumbed just inside the eighth pole and weakened through to the wire.
