TAPWRIT raced three wide early, then settled nicely off the pace near the inside, began to move up between rivals entering the far turn, gained quickly into contention on the turn, moved to the three path for a clear run, rallied strongly outside of the leader passing the quarter pole, easily took command, pulled away under left hand urging in upper stretch and was kept to the task. STATE OF HONOR raced four wide early, pulled his way to the front, set the pace racing near the inside, responded when asked, was no match for the winner but continued gamely to the finish for place honors. WILD SHOT angled over to the rail soon after the start, settled off the pace inside, moved up three wide on the far turn, came three wide into the lane and rallied mildly to get up for third. NO DOZING raced between horses on the first turn, then stalked three wide, chased two wide on the far turn, weakened and finished evenly late. BEASLEY bobbed at the break and was bumped, raced four wide early, then three wide on the first turn, raced three and four wide on the backside, moved up three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the lane and continued evenly to the finish. BASHA chased inside, moved up a bit on the far turn, then raced evenly in the stretch. TALE OF SILENCE raced off the pace inside, then between rivals, came wide for the drive and failed to threaten. SONIC MULE was bumped at the start, raced three wide early, chased two wide, chased inside on the far turn and tired. ZION VALLEY was outrun early, then pulled up on the far turn and walked off. THE MONEY MONSTER raced off the pace inside, was pulled up on the far turn and walked off.
