By subscription of \$150 each which should accompany the nomination, \$1,250 to pass the entry box and \$1,750 additional to start with \$350,000 Guaranteed, with 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% to sixth. Weight 122 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade I at one mile or over, 2 lbs.; \$60,000 or a Grade II at one mile or over, 4 lbs.; three races other maiden, claiming or starter, 6 lbs. (Maiden, Claiming and Starter races not considered in estimating weight allowances). Starters and riders to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. This field will be limited to twelve starters. In the event more than twelve pass through the entry box, the twelve starters will be determined with preference given to Grade I, II or III Stakes winners in that order, then those that have accumulated the highest career earnings. For those that enter and are eliminated under these conditions, the nomination and entry fees will be refunded. **SUPPLEMENTARY NOMINATIONS OF \$7,500 EACH** (which include the entry and starting fees) **CLOSE WEDNESDAY, MARCH 7, 2012 BY THE USUAL TIME OF CLOSING. NOMINATIONS CLOSED SATURDAY, FEBRUARY 25, 2012 WITH 38 NOMINATIONS AND 1 SUPPLEMENTAL NOMINATION (Cloudy 70)**

Dark Bay or Brown Colt, (Feb), by Malibu Moon - Spirited Away by Awesome Again. Trainer Casse E. Mark. Bred by Spendthrift Farm LLC(KY).

PROSPECTIVE never far back, was angled off the rail on the backstretch, bid in the second turn to gain a short lead, held on well when headed a furlong out then came back on again late to be up in time. GOLDEN TICKET made an inside middle move in traffic, got through along the rail to challenge in the furlong grounds and gain a short lead only to be outkicked to the wire while best of the rest. COZZETTI was slow to settle, swung wide out of the second turn then made up some ground late. SPRING HILL FARM hit the side of the starting gate at the break to get away awkwardly, chased four wide, bid after five furlongs then weakened in the drive. RAVELO'S BOY swung well wide out of the second turn then lodged a mild bid. BATTLE HARDENED stalked the pace outside for six furlongs but had no rally. TWIN was squeezed back at the break. CHIEF ENERGY raced evenly. FOX RULES chased early then faded. CAJUN CHARLIE rushed to a quick lead early but had little left after six furlongs. TELL ALL YOU KNOW chased early then faded.
