6 FURLONGS. (1.08¹) STAKES. Purse \$300,000 THOROUGHBRED CLUB OF AMERICA S.(GRADE III) FOR FILLIES AND MARES, THREE YEARS OLD AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$150 each, which should accompany the nomination or by Supplementary Nomination of \$15,000 at time of entry (Includes entry and starting fees). \$1,500 to enter and an additional \$1,500 to start, with \$300,000 guaranteed, of which \$186,000 to the owner of the winner, \$60,000 to second, \$30,000 to third, \$15,000 to fourth and \$9,000 to fifth. Weight: Three year old fillies, 122 lbs., Older, 124 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade I in 2007 allowed 2 lbs.; a Grade II in 2007, 4 lbs.; a Grade III or \$60,000 once in 2007, 6 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. A gold julep cup and a Thoroughbred Club of America trophy will be presented to the owner of the winner. Closed Wednesday, September 26, 2007 with 27 nominations. (Cloudy 88)

Bay Filly, (Apr), by Forest Wildcat - Diamonds and Legs by Quiet American. Trainer Perkins, Jr. W. Benjamin. Bred by New Farm(NJ).

WILD GAMS settled three or four wide early, raced between foes under confident handling into the upper stretch, worked her way out six wide leaving the furlong pole and edged clear late under strong hand urging. SUGAR SWIRL, near the inside and between foes while never far back, split horses four wide through close quarters leaving the furlong grounds, was inside the winner but couldn't match strides as second best. BARONESS THATCHER, within easy striking distance near the inside, was steadied at the five-sixteenths pole, split rivals three wide in the last eighth, loomed prominently but couldn't muster the needed response. MARY DELANEY tracked the pace four or five wide into the last eighth and came up empty. LADY BELSARA, up close inside front-running HOT STORM to the stretch, gradually weakened. HOT STORM gained the lead early, raced three wide, held the advantage into the final furlong and faltered. TIME'S MISTRESS, within striking distance four wide to the stretch, weakened when straightened for the drive. BLUESBDANCING, outrun four wide to the lane, came wider for the drive and never fired. COSTUME DESIGNER, off a bit slow, never was a factor and raced eight wide into the stretch.
