GROUPIE DOLL settled in hand, pulled to close the gap through the turn, was bottled up nearing the quarter pole, split rivals entering the stretch and drew away to score as the rider pleased. STRIKE THE MOON stalked the pace, ranged up five wide to make her bid, was no match for the winner but kept on fairly well to earn the place. HONEY CHILE set the pressured pace along the inside, but weakened during the drive and settled for the show. ZERMATT was allowed to settle, came five wide and improved position through the lane. MEGA DREAM stalked the pace, drew even three wide with a quarter to run, but flattened during the drive and gave way. NEWSTOUSE prompted the pace two wide to the stretch and faded. SALLY SALLY was allowed to settle four wide and lacked a response when called upon. EMMA'S ENCORE was slow into stride and was never a factor. GIANT SENSATION saved ground to no avail.
