ROCKETRY just off the inside at the tail of the field early on, continued just off the inside through the first turn before tipping four paths off the rail into the backstretch patiently handled and unhurried in the early going, got given some rein and advanced powerfully from the seven-sixteenths into contention three furlongs from home, seized command at the five-sixteenths put to coaxing, cornered four wide at the top of the stretch. inched away under a drive kept to task to prevail. YOU'RE TO BLAME coaxed from the gate, settled tracking along the inside past the stands for the first time and through the opening bend before tipping three wide into the backstretch, remained patiently handled as the top pair slipped away widening from the rest down the backstretch, came under coaxing at the nine-sixteenths, advanced on the leader in tandem with the aforementioned foe albeit under more pressure from his rider, spun just off the inside for home, dug in under a drive threatening to the eighth pole before being gradually shaken off by the top one through to the wire and was along well clear of the rest and second best. WAR STORY established the front and showed the way just off the inside past the stands for the first time before taking to the rail through the first turn, came under accompaniment to the outside from ARCHANOVA and slipped away in tandem with that foe down the backstretch taking to the two or three path, had the rest of the field begin to advance near the far turn and came under threat from the top pair as ARCHANOVA threw in the towel at the half mile pole, came under urging seven-sixteenths from home, yielded command with five-sixteenths to go, cut the corner into upper stretch and weakened. ARCHANOVA hustled from the gate, raced three wide past the stands for the first time forwardly placed and continued three wide into the first turn before advancing to tuck to the two path latching on the aforementioned foe into the backstretch, prompted that rival from the outside in the four path widening away as a pair from the rest, came under urging at the nine-sixteenths tucking three wide, began to retreat and tucked to the two path now in behind a trio three furlongs from home, swung three wide into upper stretch backing away and tired in the stretch. G ZAP five paths off the inside early on, tucked to the two path into the first turn, tipped back four to five wide into the backstretch, remained patiently handled four to five wide into the far turn, came under a drive three furlongs from home, went six to seven wide into upper stretch making no headway and tired.
