1 MILE. (1.32²) STAKES. Purse \$250,000 *TEMPTED S. (GRADE III)* FOR FILLIES TWO YEARS OLD. By subscription of \$250 each which should accompany the nomination; \$1,250 to pass the entry box and an additional \$1,250 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental nomination payment of \$2,500 along with the entry and starting fees may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. The owner of any two year old who has broken its maiden in a race held at the Aqueduct Spring or Belmont Spring/Summer meetings is eligible to receive a one time \$100,000 bonus should that horse go on to win a graded sweepstake at any NYRA track in 2014. The bonus will be reflected in the horse's earnings. 121 lbs. Non-winners of \$60,000 allowed, 2 lbs.; a sweepstake or two races, 4 lbs.; a race 6 lbs. (Maiden and claiming races not considered in allowances.) A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Clo sed Saturday, October 18, 2014 with 30 Nominations. (Clear 47)

JACARANDA broke out at the start bumping repeatedly and leaning on ENCHANTRESS for a few strides, established the pace just off the inside in hand, got roused cutting the corner into upper stretch, edged away under a drive. PAULASSILVERLINING two to three wide in pursuit from mid pack, came under encouragement midway on the turn, spun just off the inside for home, kicked on willingly through the lane unable to reel in the top one while safe for the place honors. SAVE ROCK AND ROLL hit the off side stall at the start getting away last and conceding four lengths to the front, settled three wide towards the rear, came under urging midway on the turn to advance into prominence nearing the quarter pole, continued three wide for home, offered up a mild kick for the show. SUNDAY SONNET forwardly placed five to six wide early on, shifted to the four path into the turn, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, cornered three wide for home and tired in the drive. ENCHANTRESS bumped at the start repeatedly and leaned on by JACARANDA breaking outwards, raced three to four wide in range of the front for a half before retreating through the turn to near the rear. MISS ALWAYS READY four to five wide in range of the front early on, faded after a half. HARLAN'S HONOR bobbled at the start under hustling, chased inside in range early on, grew detached into the turn from the main body of the field and proved no factor.
