1M70YDS. (1:41) STAKES. Purse \$60,000 Tenacious S.FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. Free nomination by Saturday, December 5. \$300 to enter; \$300 additional to start. Supplemental nominations of \$1,000 will be accepted at time of entry which shall include all fees. \$60,000 Guaranteed of which 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 4% to fourth, 2% to fifth and 1% to starters sixth through ninth. Weights: Three Year Olds, 121 lbs; Older, 124 lbs. Non-winners of \$35,000 at a mile or over since October 19, allowed 2 lbs, \$25,000 of such a race since then allowed 4 lbs, \$20,000 at a mile or over since September 19, allowed 6 lbs. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. The Tenacious Stakes will be limited to twelve (12) starters. High weights will be preferred. Different owners have equal draw according to weights. Horses having common ties through ownership cannot start to the exclusion of a single interest. Any horse excluded from running because of the aforementioned preference shall be refunded the entry fee or supplementary nomination fee if applicable. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Nominations Closed Saturday, December 5, 2015 with 20. (Clear 55)

Chestnut Colt, (Jan), by Candy Ride (ARG) - Sea Gull by Mineshaft. Trainer Neil J. Howard. Bred by W. S. Farish (KY).

EAGLE settled on the inside, was asked to move closer late on the backstretch, drafted inside on the far turn, slipped off the rail at the top of the stretch, made a bid outside of the leader at the three-sixteenths, edged clear into the final furlong and proved best under a confident hand ride. FREESTYLER raced in the two path on the first turn, was unhurried towards the rear, came under urging while in the two path early on the far turn, dropped to the rail late on that bend, cut the corner into the stretch, moved out under a drive at the three-sixteenths, chased under a right-handed whip into the final furlong, switched to a left-handed whip at the sixteenth-pole and finished with good courage while second best. RIDE ON CURLIN went two to three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, was coaxed along midway down the backstretch, raced in the two path on the far turn, came under the whip in upper stretch and lacked the needed kick while able to get the show. TREASURY BILL went three wide on the first turn, settled at the rear, was urged along in the three path early on the far turn, angled to five path near the five-sixteenths and lacked the needed response. NATES MINESHAFT went to the front, raced in the two path on the first turn, set the pace through solid fractions, vied a bit off the rail on the far turn, lost the lead while under a drive in upper stretch and gave way. SUPERMASON went three to four wide on the first turn, stalked the pace on the outside, was asked while two to three wide on the far turn, chased into upper stretch, had the rider lose his whip at the three-sixteenths and capitulated. WITT SIX broke out at the start, went four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was asked while three to four wide on the far turn and failed to respond.
