INDIAN BLESSING bumped at the start, stalked the leaders while five wide along the backstretch, launched a rally from outside midway on the turn, took charge approaching the quarter pole, opened a comfortable advantage in midstretch and drew away with authority under a vigorous hand ride. SWEET HOPE was rated behind horses along the backstretch, settled in midpack for a half, swung five wide while gaining at the top of the stretch and finished willingly in the middle of the track to best the others. MS. MARGARET H. angled to the rail after breaking slowly, trailed while saving ground for a half, moved out on the turn, swung six wide in upper stretch and lacked a strong closing response. PALANKA CITY rushed up to take the early lead, set the pace in the three path along the backstretch, maintained a narrow lead to the turn and steadily tired thereafter. J Z WARRIOR bumped with the winner while breaking outward at the start, pressed the pace between horses for a half, dropped back on the turn, drifted wide at the quarter pole and gave way in upper stretch. TEQUILAS DAYJUR saved ground for a half, and lacked a further response.
