The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers. 122 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade 1 in 2010 or a Grade 2 twice in 2010 allowed 2 lbs.; a Grade 1 in 2009 or a Grade 2 in 2010, 4 lbs.; a Graded Sweepstake, 6 lbs. Trophies will be presented to the winning owner, trainer and jockey. Closed Saturday, July 24, 2010 with 29 Nominations. (Clear 80)

Bay Filly, (Feb), by Medaglia d'Oro - Champagne Glow by Saratoga Six. Trainer Guillot J. Eric. Bred by Liberation Farm(KY).
CHAMPAGNE D'ORO away from the starting gate in good order, assumed a forward position, prompted the pacesetter between rivals, while placed under a good hold, kept up the pressure on the leader during the run around the bend, responded well when called upon turning for home, wrested the lead away by the three-sixteenths pole, emerged from the furlong grounds with a comfortable advantage, then proceeded to draw off under strong handling. BONNIE BLUE FLAG raced within striking distance from the two path, remained on hold until upper stretch, was set down after being straightened away, proved no match for the top one during the final furlong, but came home willingly to garner place honors. BELLE OF THE HALL bumped at the start, brought up the back of the pack while travelling in the three path, displayed a good kick during the stretch run en route for the show. LOVELY LIL veered outward at the break, was taken up sharply after bumping with BELLE OF THE HALL, recovered to be a forward factor during the early stages, only to drop back by the time she reached the half mile pole, commenced her rally at the five-sixteenths pole, was stacked four wide at the head of the stretch, then continued on home mildly, outkicking mainly weak and tired rivals. ASH ZEE was bumped after stumbling at the start, raced unhurried while along the outside until being put to encouragement at the five-sixteenths pole, continued onward after entering the stretch, split a narrow seam between rivals in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole, but could not sustain the bid leaving the eighth pole. CHRISTINE DAAE was knocked a bit sideways after being bumped shortly after the break, readily advanced forward during the run down the backstretch, pursued the pacesetter from the three path until the quarter pole before backing off. BUCKLEUPBUTTERCUP saved ground throughout, was kept on hold until the quarter pole, made a mild bid, while continuing to hug the rail, from there to the eighth pole, flattened out thereafter. PICA SLEW was guided over to the rail by the half-mile pole, cut the fractions from the inside, feeling pressure all along, gave way after turning for home. TIDAL POOL four wide around the turn, tired.
