PAOLA QUEEN was hustled from the start then urged along in the second flight, dropped back leaving the backstretch, saved ground under

a strong hand ride for most of the turn, passed the five-sixteenths under a right-handed whip then moved to the two path, shifted three wide outside the quarter-pole, spun four wide into the stretch, was switched to a left-handed whip at the three-sixteenths, was pulled in with a tug of the

left rein then pulled out shortly thereafter with the right rein, pursued the tiring vanguard into the final sixteenth under continued left-hand urging,

drifted out late and got up in a very long drive. LIGHTSTREAM dropped well off the hot pace, saved ground on the turn, was roused at the

five-sixteenths, turned into the stretch in the two path, began to angle out near the three-sixteenth but opted to stay inside of LEWIS BAY, rallied while traveling on her inside lead, gained under a right-handed whip, made a bid at the sixteenth-pole but missed while just able to get the place. OFF THE TRACKS was hustled from the start, pressed the fast pace on the outside, drew even with the leader leaving the backstretch, dueled in the two path on the turn, came under a left-handed whip in upper stretch, inched clear while switched to a right-handed whip at the furlong marker,

clung to a narrow advantage into the final sixteenth, went back to a left-handed whip late and was caught while clear for the show. LEWIS BAY tracked the pace on the outside while racing in the second flight, stalked the leading duo in the three path on the turn, was given her cue outside the quarter-pole, made an outside bid at the top of the stretch, came under a right-handed whip at the three-sixteenths, dropped back into the final furlong then weakened. ONE TRUE KISS was void of speed, saved ground on the turn, moved out in upper stretch then was put to the whip and failed to threaten. KAREENA showed good speed after breaking well, set the pace under pressure through blistering fractions, dueled with OFF

THE TRACKS while inside on the turn, dropped out turning into the stretch and gave way. KINSLEY KISSES settled on the outside, was urged along in the four path on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and failed to respond.
