SEPARATIONOFPOWERS at a considerable distance from off the inside throughout, departed the backstretch towards path four, picked up interest as the half was being completed and crept up to MIA MISCHIEF, spun into the lane eye to eye with that foe, settled in upper stretch and had the rider go to work, as a stretch-long duel got ignited, saw the rider apply stick work from the right side, attempting to hold her ground against a rival heck-bent on getting out, bumped thrice with that opponent during the going from the furlong grounds to the sixteenth pole, with the second one being the hardest, was vanked off the nemesis, forged her way to the top, now no longer directly abreast of MIA MISCHIEF then gamely stayed in the clear. MIA MISCHIEF prompted CLASSY ACT well out in the strip on the backstretch, pulling with force on the left side, slid over closer to the rail untl two to three wide after stepping onto the turn, went to front end all by in the vicinity of the three-eighths pole, with the move done quite effortlessly, felt the presence of the eventual winner a furlong down the road, swung into the lane on near even terms, fought valiantly, rider still with a strong grip on the left, but able to get in some light shots of his own from the opposite direction, bumped with the top one several times from midstretch to the sixteenth pole, relinquished reluctantly and had to settle for being second best. KELLY'S HUMOR darted over to the two path after the start, cut over to the inside route coming up to the half mile pole, rode the rail to the end of the bend, angled back into path two for the drive home, unleashed a bold burst of speed, splitting foes in midstretch, continued onward rallying for the show, then had a good gallop out to the top of the clubhouse bend. ALTER MOON pursued the front runners from path two, pulling on the left, angled six wide into the stretch, put in a mild bid during the first half of the stretch run before flattening out. NORMA'S CHARM two wide, got roused after the half had been completed, lacked a response. MINIT TO STARDOM stumbled at the start, recovered in short order, was cautiously ridden while in close proximity to the outside of the second place finisher along the backstretch, worked out a tuck into path three by the crown of the turn, got cued up gradually shifting into path five from upper to midlane, made no headway. CLASSY ACT broke forwardly placed, was along the rail vying for command with MIA MISCHIEF, yielded without resistance as the half was being completed, tipped to the outside and drafted behind the new leader, angled back to the rail at the top of the lane and backed away. SPECTATOR leapt up, making solid contact with left side of the starting gate, travelled two wide thereafter to the guarter pole while trailing throughout.
