TEXAS AIR went four then three wide on the first turn, settled nicely off the pace, was urged along while four wide on the far turn, rallied into the final furlong, closed well to make a bid at the sixteenth-pole and prevailed under strong urging. HIP FOUR SIXTYNINE raced in the two path on the first turn, settled towards the rear, was urged along while three wide on the far turn, swung five wide into the stretch, rallied under a drive, closed well into the final sixteenth and just earned the place. RISE UP brushed with an opponent after the start, was hustled to the lead, dropped the rail midway through the first turn, set the pace through quick fractions, remained clear while under the whip into the final furlong, led into the final sixteenth but was caught while drifting out late but was clear for the show. REAL APPEAL DEAL went three wide on the first turn, lagged at the rear, was urged along while four then five wide on the far turn, came six wide into the stretch, gained ground into the final furlong but flattened out. ONE KING'S MAN angled in at the rear, lingered towards the rear while saving ground, was urged along on the far turn, moved out in upper stretch and lacked the needed response. SR. QUISQUEYANO was hustled from the start, came off the rail midway through the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, chased in the two path on the far turn and tired. HOLIDAY MISCHIEF raced in the two path on the first turn, was forwardly placed down the backstretch, chased three wide on the far turn and weakened. F J UNCLE VIC went five then four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while four to five wide on the final turn and failed to respond. BRONCE BELLATOR was restless in the gate, went two to three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, came up empty on the far turn and retreated. MAL GUAPO was hustled from the start, went four wide on the first turn, raced towards the front while on the outside, came up empty while four wide on the far turn and stopped.
