JAGUAR PAW was sent over to the inside by the end of the backstretch, vied to maintain command, with the rider attempting to keep something in reserve, got asked for run for the stretch, gave it and drew well clear, was under hand urging crossing the finish line. SKY BLAZER on the track early, contently kept an eye on the front runners while sitting a loose pocket trip, was put to urging and angled outward coming to the five-sixteenths pole, eventually turned for home three wide and under a drive, proved no match. LOVE TO RUN got displaced on the front end shortly after the initial split had been recorded, went on to press the issue from the two path during the run around the bend, gave way. JOAN'S CHOICE gave chase from off the inside, was put into the four path after going halfway around the turn, was guided back into the two path spinning into the lane, tired. SHKSPEARE SHALIYAH devoid of early speed, picked up the pace slightly under some encouragement leaving the half mile pole, trailed.
