MOR CHANCES unhurried while travelling in the three path, was swung five wide turning for home, quickly settled into his rally after being given his cue in upper stretch, advanced steadily towards the leader and was along in time, despite drifting out in the late stages from a strong left handed whip. GOOD CARD within striking distance three wide, ground his way to a slim edge at the sixteenth pole, was overtaken by the top one soon afterwards but dug in with determination to preserve the place. GOLD AND ROSES between rivals, ducked inward approaching the quarter pole to take over the position abandoned by SPANKY FISCHBEIN, came home with good energy while remaining glued to the inside throughout the length of the stretch. ALMIGHTY SILVER under a firm hold taking the inside route, was eased off the inside after gaining the needed room late on the turn, remained on hold until turning for home, was stacked six wide at the head of the stretch, responded positively when roused and displayed a good, belated rally. SPANKY FISCHBEIN well placed inside, was angled outward nearing the quarter pole to do battle, came up empty when called upon. IRISH BLAST broke alertly to grab command, remained a prominent factor until the eighth pole and tired. OEDIPUS O'NEAL gave way after going a half. PRINCE OF PEACE had a four wide journey and folded.
