7 FURLONGS. (1:20) STAKES. Purse \$100,000 Toboggan S.FOR FOUR YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$100 each which should accompany the nominations; \$500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$500 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental nomination payment of \$1,000 along with the entry and starting fees may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. Weight, 123 lbs. Non-winners of a Graded Sweepstake in 2017-18 allowed 3 lbs.; of \$60,000 in 2017-18 other than State-Bred stake allowed 5 lbs.; of three races in 2017-18, 7 lbs.; of two races in 2017-18, 9 lbs. (Maiden, claiming, starter and State-bred allowance races not considered in allowances). A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, January 13, 2018 with 12 Nominations. (Clear 49)

GREAT STUFF squeezed at the break along with fellow rival LIFE IN SHAMBLES, got guided over towards the inside soon afterwards, eventually taking up residence at a slight distance from off the inside, kept an eye on a pair going eye to eye with other for the opening half and a little beyond, picked up interest getting taken to the outside past the five-sixteenths marker, was ultimately fanned out into path five for optimal racing clearance, kicked into his best and was the first to wear down a twosome that had been dueling nearly from the get-go, drew clear of the others then had plenty left in the final stages to turn back a late bid coming from VULCAN'S FORGE. VULCAN'S FORGE broke slightly to the outside, enough so however to become one of the bookends putting the squeeze on another two at the start, showed no lasting ill effects from that incident, cut over to the inside and proceeded along bringing up the back of the pack, devoid of any semblance of speed, sprang to life during the last few jumps of the run around the bend, was sent out into path seven from upper to midlane, becoming the widest of all, straightened away and began to rally in earnest, flashed strong, but belated foot to be along for the place. TAKAFUL unscathed at the break, went at it one on one with GREEN GRATTO, riding the rail while going about at the task, saw its pilot put the mount to a drive approaching the quarter pole, successfully shook free of the nemesis only to have others bearing down hard by the furlong grounds, relinquished in the vicinity of the eighth pole then steadily weakened into the show slot. LIFE IN SHAMBLES squeezed at the break, got set up in the pocket, sat within range of the fighting front runners, inched his way off the inside route then was put to a drive swinging three wide into the stretch, lacked the needed response. SUMMER REVOLUTION two to three wide on the turn, commenced the stretch in path four, gave way. GREEN GRATTO made contact with LIFE IN SHAMBLES after moving inward springing from the gate, recovered and powered his way into a prominent position, rider atop with a firm grip, was in the two path co-sharing the lead with TAKAFUL, failed to respond when asked for more early in the stretch drive and backed away.
