7 FURLONGS. (1:20) STAKES. Purse \$100,000 (Includes \$900 Starters Bonus. Pluses \$900 Starters Bonus.) Toboggan S. (Grade III) FOR FOUR YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$100 each which should accompany the nominations; \$500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$500 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental nomination payment of \$1,000 (along with the entry and starting fees) may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 55% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 12% to third, 6% to fourth, 4% to fifth and 3% divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. Weight, 124 lbs. Non-winners of a Graded Sweepstake in 2018-19 allowed 2 lbs.; of a sweepstake other than State-Bred in 2018-19 allowed 4 lbs.; of three races other than maiden, claiming, starter or State-bred allowance in 2018-19 allowed 6 lbs. SOLID WAGER five to six wide in pursuit from the tail of the compact field down the backstretch, tucked three to four wide through the turn coming under coaxing three furlongs from home, went six wide into upper stretch, rallied under an off sided stick coming in to look the leader in the eye a furlong from home, took command a sixteenth out and inched away to the finish kept to task. SKYLER'S SCRAMJET bobbled slightly at the break, recovered to establish the front and show the way along the inside lightly coaxed along through swift splits, came under growing pressure from COLONEL SHARP to the outside through the latter portion of the turn and was put to urging five-sixteenths out, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, shook away to the eighth pole, came under growing threat to the outside, yielded the front a sixteenth from home and ran on to preserve the place honors. GOLD FOR THE KING bobbled slightly at the start, got put to brief coaxing and angled out to chase four wide down the backstretch from just off the pace, tucked three wide through the turn coming under coaxing at the three-eighths, angled five wide into upper stretch, stayed on one paced through the stretch to the finish improving position for the show honors as a pair of rivals backed away. BAL HARBOUR five paths off the inside down the backstretch, tucked to the two path half a mile from home, came under a ride three furlongs out, swung four wide into upper stretch, dug in under a drive but was outkicked. COLONEL SHARP hustled from the gate, raced two to three wide in closest aim of the leader, got placed to coaxing at the seven-sixteenths and advanced midway on the turn to issue a challenge five-sixteenths from home, couldn't get by the leader and was rebuffed swinging three wide at the quarter pole, then weakened once straightened away for home. All riders carried an additional two pounds as mandated by a weather-related safety initiative.
