SILVER TRAIN broke well, raced with the pace along the rail into the turn, was eased back, angled out, rallied three wide approaching the stretch, collared WAR FRONT coming to the eighth pole, dug in determinedly outside and bested that rival under a drive. WAR FRONT flashed good speed from the start, set the pace under pressure, responded when confronted by the winner and dug in gamely along the inside to the finish. BIG APPLE DADDY raced in hand outside, was four wide on the turn and had no response when roused. ANEW raced with the pace while in hand, pressed WAR FRONT while three wide on the turn and tired after entering the stretch. MACH SPEED raced wide throughout and tired in the stretch. VOODOO was rated along inside and tired.
