TOP TIER LASS came away in good order, departed the backstretch four wide, the widest member of the early pace skirmish, moved when forced and overhauled the other three midway during the run around the bend, doing so with only the slightest of hand movement, was gradually guided over to the rail once sufficiently clear, making it over completely to the rail by the quarter pole, responded positively when given her cue, accelerated away from the competition to arrive at the eighth pole with a comfortable advantage, extended the winning margin, crossing the wire under a vigorous hand ride. SMITTENWITHKITTEN in a step at the start, was gently pulled off the nearest opponent before any contact could be made, raced three wide around the turn, proved no match for the top one but held on well to secure second. JANE OF ALL TRADES took the inside, steadied when in tight cutting the corner into the stretch, remained in traffic for another furlong, angled outward, bothering both REGAL JOANNE (directly) and SABEL BROWNE (indirectly), cautiously tread his way between rivals a sixteenth down the road, flashed some interest once safely through to take the show. APPLE CIDER dropped back several lengths after being forwardly in the early stages, tucked along the inside and was put to some coaxing, regained some of the lost ground, was angled outward coming to the five-sixteenths pole, kept going wider and wider until in the five path by the head of the stretch, got straightened away, flattened out during the last eighth. MARIEL N KATHY raced three wide, contested the pace from between rivals until about the midway point on the turn, started losing contact with the top one at this juncture and got put to a drive by the five-sixteenths pole, folded. PRISCILLA MARIE hustled to the top, argued for control from the rail while being hounded by a threesome, remained a prominent factor for an in the money finish until mid lane before backing away. SABEL BROWNE (IRE) raced along the outside, was in the three path leaving the five-sixteenths pole, appeared a bit green in upper stretch drifting back inward during the opening phases of the stretch run, ducked outward though after ROYAL JOANNE did near the furlong marker, failed to make an impact. REGAL JOANNE disputed the pace from between rivals until near the three-eighths pole, was retreating when forced to check, bothered by JANE OF ALL TRADES near midstretch.
