APPLICATOR was close up four wide, forged command nearing the quarter pole, kept on well under steady urging and edged clear. FLATLINED was shuffled back at the start, was unhurried at the tail of the field, took closer order midway through the turn, angled out five wide entering the stretch, kicked on well but was unable to bridge the gap. SHINING COPPER vied for the lead between horses, settled off of the pace down the hill, rallied through traffic and was making up ground. IRISH STRAIT was allowed to settle, tucked in to save ground, got through into the lane, finished willingly and was making up ground. WESTERN RESERVE contested the pace three deep through the turn, then toward the inside thereafter, but weakened slightly during drive and grudgingly gave in. ZAMBIAN settled three wide, tipped out further for the final furlong but failed to make headway. BANDAR was allowed to settle, moved up four wide and loomed a danger entering the stretch, but faltered in the final furlong and faded. HOOTENANNY disputed the pace along the inside, but came up empty before going six furlongs and dropped out.
