By subscription of \$100 each, which should accompany the nomination or by Supplementary Nomination of \$4,500 at time of entry (includes entry and starting fees). \$750 to enter and an additional \$750 to start, with \$150,000 guaranteed, of which \$90,000 to the owner of the winner, \$30,000 to second, \$15,000 to third, \$7,500 to fourth, \$4,500 to fifth and \$3,000 to be divided equally among sixth through last. Weight: 123 lbs. Non-winners of \$60,000 at a mile or over on the turf allowed 3 lbs.; \$45,000 at a mile or over on the turf, 5 lbs. The maximum number of starters for the Transylvania will be limited to twelve with two also eligibles. In the event that more than twelve pass the entry box, the twelve starters will be determined at that time with preference to graded stakes winners (in order I-II-III), then highest turf earnings. Failure to draw into the race cancels all fees. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Keeneland will present a trophy cup to the winning owner. Nominations closed on Wednesday, March 22, 2017 with 39 Nominations. In the event that this race is taken off the turf it will be contested at One Mile and One-Sixteenth on the main track. BIG SCORE settled between rivals, took closer order through the second turn, worked his way through traffic into the lane, shifted to the outside of HOLIDAY STONE for the final furlong, and wore that one down in the final yards. HOLIDAY STONE opened clear to dictate terms, turned back the bid of SONIC BOOM leaving the second turn, kicked clear into the stretch, fought doggedly but was unable to resist the winner. MAKARIOS was unhurried and settled at the tail of the field, closed the gap some on the second turn, angled to the far outside nearing the furlong marker, kept on well and was getting to the leaders. TICONDEROGA was allowed to settle, circled into the stretch six wide and improved position. OSCAR PERFORMANCE broke a step slow, rushed to contention along the inside, attended the pace in hand to the stretch, got through entering the stretch but lacked a response when put to pressure. COWBOY CULTURE was close up three wide, was collared between foes leaving the second turn and gave way. SONIC BOOM was forwardly placed three deep, took his run at the leader nearing the five-sixteenths pole, but came up empty entering the stretch and faded. PROFITEER saved ground to no avail.
