1 1/8 MILE. (Turf) (1:43²) STAKES. Purse \$150,000 Kentucky Utilities Transylvania S. (Grade III) FOR THREE YEAR OLDS. By subscription of \$100 each, which should accompany the nomination or by Supplementary Nomination of \$4,500 at time of entry (includes entry and starting fees). \$750 to enter and an additional \$750 to start, with \$150,000 guaranteed, of which \$90,000 to the owner of the winner, \$30,000 to second, \$15,000 to third, \$7,500 to fourth, \$4,500 to fifth and \$3,000 to be divided equally among sixth through last. Weight: 123 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade I stakes at a mile or over on the turf allowed 3 lbs.; a sweepstakes on the turf, 5 lbs. The maximum number of starters for the Kentucky Utilities Transylvania will be limited to fourteen with two also eligibles. In the event that more than fourteen pass the entry box, the fourteen starters will be determined at that time with preference to graded stakes winners (in order I-II-III), then highest turf earnings. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Keeneland will present a trophy cup to the winning owner. Nominations closed Wednesday, March 20, 2019 with 42 nominations. In the event that this race is taken off the turf it will be contested at One Mile and One-Sixteenth on the main track. (Rail at 15 feet). (Cloudy 55)

AVIE'S FLATTER chased the pace while being bottled up until nearing the lane, came out and bumped a foe near the five sixteenth pole trying to find room, shifted into the four path entering the lane finally clear, made a rally once clear down the lane, edged clear and held in the final stages. HENLEY'S JOY trailed the field early on, shifted into the four path in the far turn, rallied down the lane, was gaining late but did not have enough in the final stages. THE BLACK ALBUM (FR) stalked the pace early, angled off the rail into the lane, made a bid in the stretch but flattened out late in the drive. WAR FILM was back early on, angled off the rail into the lane, rallied along the rail down the lane and was gaining in the late stages. ONTHEWAYTONEVRLAND (IRE) set the pace early, angled off the rail into the lane and yielded late in the stretch drive. LOUDER THAN BOMBS chased the pace early, swung into the six path in the far turn and leveled off late in the stretch. WEEKLY CALL tracked the pace early, shifted into the three path in the far turn and faded down the lane. DUNPH chased the pace early, was bumped near the five sixteenth pole, fanned into the five path entering the lane and was empty late.
