SIREN LURE chased off the rail, came three deep into the stretch, bid outside rivals to gain the lead past midstretch and pulled clear under some urging. BATTLE WON stalked three deep then off the rail on the turn, bid outside the pacesetter under urging in the stretch, had the rider lose the whip between foes late but held the place. UNFURL THE FLAG sped to the early lead, set the pace a bit off the rail then inside on the turn, fought back in the stretch and bested the rest. PUBLICATION unhurried and angled in on the backstretch, came out into the stretch, split rivals in the lane and rallied to best the others. AREYOUTALKINTOME close up stalking the pace along the inside to the stretch, weakened in the final furlong. VORTEX (GB) settled off the rail then outside a rival, angled in for the stretch and lacked a rally. SEATTLE BUDDY wide early, chased three deep on the backstretch and most of the turn, angled in some nearing the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. PRORUNNER chased between horses on the backstretch and off the rail on the turn, came out into the stretch and weakened. TRICKEY TREVOR stalked the pace between horses on the backstretch and outside a rival on the turn and had little left for the stretch. THUNDER TOUCH off a bit slowly, settled inside, steadied off heels nearing the quarter pole and was not a threat.
