SHORE RUNNER was patiently handled keeping watch on the front runners, managed to make his way into the two path entering the stretch, remained unasked for its best, idling behind a wall consisting of three rivals spread out across the course, had sufficient room to angle out for freedom, as SPRING TO THE SKY was backing away, and did so with a furlong to go, was given his cue and unleashed a big burst of speed, rallied in tandem with the second place finisher past the sixteenth pole, beat that one to the front and edged away. SUMMATION TIME departed the backstretch from the three path, closed enough ground to latch on to the front runners as the trio headed into the stretch, was almost at the three-sixteenths pole before asked to give some run, seemingly the same as the two others he was teamed up with at this juncture, was rallying willingly when joined by the top one in deep stretch, proved no match for that foe's strong kick. SUMMER BREEZING assumed a forward position after the start, prompted the leader from the two path, had the runner up add its presence to the pace picture arriving at the quarter pole, spun into the stretch and was allowed to settle in before switched over to encouragement, fought from between rivals until the final seven yards, got outfinished belatedly and had to settle for the show. SOMETHING EXTRA broke on top and maintained the advantage, was rated carving out the pace from the inside, attended by SUMMER BREEZING parked out in path two, felt an increase in pressure after SUMMATION TIME zeroed in, got called upon a few jumps deep into the stretch run, yielded, put up a fight before weakening in the late stages. SPRING TO THE SKY broke a length the slowest, was well held being reserved in the two path within range of the front runners making his way on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and came up empty when asked for run.
