BENNY THE BULL was unhurried along the backstretch, gradually moved up in the two path on the turn, swung out for clear sailing at the quarter pole, advanced six wide into the stretch then closed steadily in the middle of the track to nip MAN OF DANGER in the final strides. MAN OF DANGER broke alertly then sprinted clear in the early stages, set the pace under pressure for a half, extended his lead a bit in midstretch, continued on the front while drifting out in deep stretch then yielded grudgingly. ABRAAJ stalked the pace while four wide along the backstretch, ranged up from outside to threaten at the quarter pole, closed the gap nearing the sixteenth pole and finished willingly to gain a share. THOR'S ECHO pressed the pace between horses while three wide for a half, remained a factor into midstretch and weakened late. COUNCIL MEMBER checked in tight at the start, trailed to the turn and lacked a strong closing bid. SUAVE JAZZ was in tight at the start, raced well back for a half while saving ground, angled out in upper stretch and lacked a further response. SAINT DAIMON pressed the early pace along the rail, dropped back on the turn and pulled up in distress after the finish then was vanned off.
