IMPERIAL HINT guided over towards the inside after the start, loosely drafted behind the pacesetter for a portion of the journey on the backstretch, tipped out into path three after stepping onto the turn, sat perched, keeping watch on the front runners, ranged up after the half had been run, enough so as to spin into the lane on near even terms with BOBBY ABU DHABI, was called upon a sixteenth down the road as a duel ignited between them, began the final furlong having fought its way past a determined opponent, edged away to lead by a short length at the most, felt the presence of WHITMORE in the final stages, but dug in resolutely to prevail. WHITMORE away last, was gradually worked onto the inside route making his way towards the half mile pole, was in hand scurrying into contention with a sustained rail run on the turn, got switched over to a hand ride slithering four wide, the second widest of all, into the lane, maintained the momentum after being straightened away, finished with good belated energy but came up short. BOBBY ABU DHABI broke in line with RECRUITING READY, was allowed to ease back into a stalking role, prompted the previously-mentioned rival on the turn, displaced that foe, but only narrowly, coming up to the quarter pole, got called upon at that station, relinquished reluctantly after vying with vigor against the winner during the ensuing furlong, still had some fight left afterwards before weakening in the last seventy yards. ALWAYS SUNSHINE caught directly behind the rival in distress, that being WESTWOOD, was checked as that one drifted to the outside in the vicinity of the half mile pole, recovered and resumed its pursuit three to four wide, got driven five wide, the widest of all, into the lane, had no rally. RECRUITING READY argued for the advantage along the inside, succumbed when challenged by BOBBY ABU DHABI approaching the end of the bend, stepped into the lane having little left and retreated. WESTWOOD forwardly placed three wide, lost its action after taking a bad step nearing the conclusion of the backstretch, was pulled up after being eased then was subsequently vanned off.
