By subscription of \$250 each which should accompany the nomination. \$1,250 to pass the entry box and an additional \$1,250 to start. A supplemental nomination fee of \$3,750 (in addition to the entry and starting fees) may be made at any time prior to the close of entries. The guaranteed purse will be divided as follows \$137,500 to the owner of the winner, \$50,000 to second, \$30,000 to third, \$15,000 to fourth, \$7,500 to fifth, \$5,000 to sixth with the remaining \$5,000 to be divided equally amongst the remaining finishers. CATALINA CRUISER off the inside, was sighted pulling a bit on the left departing the backstretch, sat in path three within striking distance of the ongoing pace dispute, was switched over to a light hand ride after the half mile had been reeled off and picked up interest, swung out towards the four path heading for the three-sixteenths pole, settled in and was given his cue, closed in on the ones to catch in a steadfast manner, came out after some left side pressure with approximately a sixteenth remaining, resumed a true course and clawed up to the duelers, finally wearing them down in the shadow of the finish line. STRIKE POWER gunned from the gate, came away a half length the fastest but with RECRUITING READY already hitched up, cut over to the inside, went at it on near even terms with the nemesis, under some coaxing, was the first of that twosome to have its pilot commit to a drive, this occurring in the general area of the quarter pole, vied with vigour still matched up the nemesis, was game to the end but got denied. RECRUITING READY emerged from the pack right after the start latched on to the second place finisher, shifted into the two path as a spirited tussle between them sparked off, saw them yet directly abreast of each other as they turned into the stretch, waited until the three-sixteenths pole before being set to an all out drive, remained determined, but couldn't go by. NICODEMUS pursued the front runners two to three wide on the turn, proceeded to angle to the outside heading for the top of the lane, gradually made his way into the six path over the course of the next furlong, closed in well to grab the final significant slice of the pot. STAN THE MAN tracked the disputed pace from the pocket, tipped into the two path spinning into the stretch, lacked the needed response and weakened. GOLD FOR THE KING stalked the front runners spaced a slight distance from off the rail, went three wide into the lane, made no headway. MR. DOUGIE FRESH three wide onto the turn, was sent five wide exiting it, gave way. WHITMORE parked out four wide on the bend, paused in hand off the heels of a maneuvering NICODEMUS approaching the quarter pole, got fanned out into path seven during the stretch run, failed to offer a response while being the widest of all throughout.
