A supplemental nomination fee of \$3,000 in addition to the entry fee will be accepted at any time prior to the publication of weights. All starters including supplemental nominees will receive a \$750 rebate. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. AFLEETING LADY broke well and assumed a forward position, tucked along the inside and kept a watchful eye, rider applying a firm hold, on ALL DUE RESPECT, showing the way at that time from along the outside, flip flopped paths with that opponent coming to the end of the backstretch, crept up leaving the midway point on the turn, idled in the two path just off the leader's hind quarters as the front-running pair made their way to the head of the stretch, got turned loose as a spirited tussle through the furlong grounds commenced, forged her way to a slim advantage by the eighth pole then kicked well clear, kept busy to the end. ALL DUE RESPECT came away from the starting gate with no apparent mishap and quickly established control, chose to be positioned off the inside while making her way down the backstretch, but switched over to the rail route a few strides before reaching the half mile pole, felt the winner narrowing in late but remained on hold until the top of the lane, fought with vigor from upper to midstretch but arrived at the furlong marker a sliver behind her fellow dueler, failed to keep up thereafter but continued onward willingly to secure second. NEFERTINI made light contact with ARENA ELVIRA at the break, lagged behind near the back of the pack, departed the backstretch from the three path, was taken wider and put to a drive nearing the quarter pole, eventually making it into the five path by the three-sixteenths marker, got straightened away and came home with good energy to grab the show. GO UNBRIDLED took the inside route for over three-quarters, got angled four wide for the start of the stretch run, mustered up enough of a kick to take the final major slice of the pot. R GYPSY GOLD three to four wide on the turn, had no rally. ARENA ELVIRA got bumped lightly at the start, remained unhurried from the two path for the opening six furlongs, was let out a notch and moved up willingly to split rivals in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, sustained the move until midlane then backed away. MARISTAR sat reserved from off the inside, got tipped into the three path midway on the turn and was soon asked for some run, turned for home and tired. CATCH A THIEF saved ground, cut the corner under a full drive and faltered.
