1 1/2 MILES. (Turf) (2.123) STAKES. Purse \$750,000 UNITED NATIONS S.(GRADE I) FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$500 each, which should accompany the nomination and \$7,500 to pass the entry box. The owner of the winner to receive \$450,000, \$150,000 to second, \$80,000 to third, \$42,500 to fourth, \$20,000 to fifth and \$7,500 to sixth. Three-Year-Olds: 117 lbs.; Older: 122 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade I Stake in 2006 allowed 2 lbs.; A Grade II Stake in 2006, 4 lbs. The winning owner to receive a trophy. Closed Saturday, June 24, 2006 with 21 nominations. (Should this race be taken off the turf it will be run at One Mile and One Quarter on the main track.)

ENGLISH CHANNEL came out some at the start then settled close up while saving ground, eased out three wide while lodging a bid nearing the top of the lane, reached CACIQUE(IRE) turning for home then bested that one in a prolonged drive. CACIQUE (IRE) tracked early from the two path, moved to the front between calls on the final turn, raced along the inside through the lane and responded gamely but could not resist the top one. RELAXED GESTURE (IRE) never far back and just off the inside, eased three wide for the drive and lacked a solid late response. SILVERFOOT trailed early and near the inside turning for home, moved around a rival and offered a mild bid inside. BETTER TALK NOW in a bit close slightly at the start then never far back, raced outside on the final turn, was four wide into the lane and lacked the needed response. SHAKE THE BANK saved ground while setting the early pace and weakened through the lane. RAMAZUTTI close up while three wide, had little left entering the lane.
