T. content to settle off the pace and outside rival, advanced on the final bend outside, challenged three deep entering the lane, reached the front then edged away while coming in some and safely held. DAKOTA PHONE unhurried while bit off the fence, chased two then three wide, followed winner's path into the stretch, roused left handed and rallied strongly to finish very willingly outside winner. AGGIE ENGINEER quickly stepped to the front while crossing over, dictated fractions from the inside, was overtaken in upper stretch then gamely lasted for third. TIZ WEST stalked from along the rail and inside winner, angled out on the second turn, regained the rail in the stretch but never menaced. MARLANG was washy going to the gate, conceded lead early to rival, pressured pacesetter from outside, moved up and bid between foes and inside winner into the lane but weakened in the drive.
