1 1/8 MILES. (1.432) (Off The Turf) STAKES. Purse \$125,000 VALLEY VIEW S.(GRADE III) FOR FILLIES, THREE YEARS OLD. By subscription of \$125 each which should accompany the nomination or by Supplementary Nomination of \$6,250 by time of entry (Includes entry and starting fees). \$625 to enter and an additional \$625 to start, with \$125,000 guaranteed, of which \$77,500 to the owner of the winner, \$25,000 to second, \$12,500 to third, \$6,250 to fourth and \$3,750 to fifth. Weight: 123 lbs. Non-winners of a graded or group stakes on the turf in 2006 allowed 2 lbs.; \$45,000 twice on the turf in 2006, 4 lbs.; three races other than maiden or claiming, 6 lbs. The maximum number of starters for the Valley View will be limited to twelve. In the event that more than twelve fillies pass the entry box, the twelve starters will be determined at that time with preference by condition eligibility, beginning with graded or group stakes winners. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. A gold julep cup will be presented to the owner of the winner. Closed Wednesday, October 11, 2006 with 32 nominations. In the event that this race is taken off the turf it will be contested at Eight and One Half Furlongs on the main track. (Cloudy 44)

Dark Bay or Brown Filly, (Apr), by Peaks and Valleys - Count to Six by Saratoga Six. Trainer Clement Christophe. Bred by Arthur B. Hancock III & Catesby W. Clay (KY).

MERIBEL, taken in hand soon after the start and eased back last, raced six wide on the backstretch, circled the field ten wide leaving the second turn, bumped briefly with PURE INCENTIVE when straightened for the drive, worked her way in five or six wide soon after, then bested PRECIOUS KITTEN in a game effort. PRECIOUS KITTEN, never far back, raced five wide, moved seven or eight wide leaving the second turn, came out and bumped with PURE INCENTIVE entering the upper stretch, reached the front between calls in deep stretch but was outfinished. MAY NIGHT, rated along three wide and forwardly placed from the beginning, reached the front concluding the second turn but wasn't good enough in a long drive. PURE INCENTIVE, reserved early and five wide, edged in a bit entering the far turn, moved with the winner nine wide nearing the stretch, was bumped by PRECIOUS KITTEN entering the upper stretch and forced out on MERIBEL for a stride, was forced in by that rival soon after to be in behind horses and couldn't make up the difference. RASTA FARIAN went up early to force the pace four or five wide, battled up close into the stretch and weakened. J'RAY, unhurried early and six wide to the far turn, edged in between foes when advancing on the far turn, came out again to be seven wide when straightened for the drive and improved position. MYSTERIOUS LINA (FR) raced in a striking position between foes four or five wide, made a menacing run when asked approaching the stretch but flattened out in the drive. DELMARVA, within striking distance and between horses four wide, lost a bit of position on the far turn, continued between rivals into the lane and lacked a late account. SOUTHERN PROTOCOL tired approaching the stretch while between foes. SOOTHSAY (IRE) moved inside early, then failed to rally. TRANSMIT raced in contention for six furlongs and weakened. TIZ A FANTASY stalked the pace for three-quarter and tired. IDLE QUEST gained the lead early, raced three or four wide and faltered approaching the stretch.
