Bay Filly, (Apr), by Lemon Drop Kid - Pleasant Review by Pleasant Tap. Trainer Colebrook Ben. Bred by Edward A. Seltzer(KY). SPARKLING REVIEW settled in hand four wide, took closer order through the second turn, tipped out six wide entering the stretch, took over nearing the furlong marker and kicked clear. SPRING INCLUDED opened clear to set the pace, was collared midway through the second turn, rebuffed that rival entering the stretch, was tackled again in earnest nearing the furlong marker, was unable to match that rival but dug in gamely to preserve the place. GOLDY ESPONY (FR) was unhurried into stride, responded when roused with three furlongs to run, circled six wide and was making up ground. FASHION FUND (GB) settled at the tail of the field, swung nine wide leaving the second turn but found her best stride too late. V V GOODNIGHT settled saving ground, shifted out and around a tiring rival entering the stretch, dropped back to the inside and improved position. ANNULMENT contended between horses, bid three wide but lacked the needed late response. STELLARIS contended between horses shifted out seven wide but went evenly. MISS FROST tracked the pace four wide, but faltered between horses entering the stretch and faded. A LITTLE BIT SASSY stalked the pace, moved up five wide to make her bid, but failed to sustain the drive. ROSALIND attended the pace along the inside, but came up empty after six furlongs and retreated. VALSEUSE was slow into stride, tucked in to save ground?but showed little thereafter. SIZE was fractious in the gate, was close up three wide through the second turn and dropped out.
