SEAN AVERY bumped lightly with CALIBRACHÓA at the start, was hustled to the lead then moved clear, controlled the action while off the rail on the turn, responded well when set down at the top of the stretch, came under a right-handed whip near the three-sixteenths pole,

maintained a length lead into the final furlong and held gamely under strong handling. TRAPPE SHOT was urged along on the outside, raced

four wide on the turn, came under a right-handed whip in upper stretch, switched to a left-handed whip passing the eighth-pole, closed gradually on the outside in the final furlong and just missed. CALIBRACHOA bumped lightly with SEAN AVERY at the start, chased the pace raced inside on the turn, was put to the whip near the five-sixteenths pole, battled determinedly along the rail in the stretch but was outfinished while clear for the show. APRIORITY was urged along while just off the pace, chased three wide on the turn, came under left hand urging in

upper stretch and tired. NOBLE'S PROMISE was hard ridden towards the rear of the field, raced off the rail on the turn, came under the whip with three furlongs to run and failed to rally. HAMAZING DESTINY was urged along while off the pace, raced two then three wide on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and also failed to rally. BANK MERGER was ridden along at the back of the field, went three wide on the turn and failed to threaten. ATTA BOY ROY was hustled from the start, chased the pace, dropped back near the half-mile pole, raced inside on the

turn and came up empty.
