By subscription of \$350 each which should accompany the nomination; \$1,750 to pass the entry box and an additional \$1,750 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$3,500 along with the entry and starting fees may be made at any time prior to the publication of weights. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. Trophies will be presented to the winning owner, trainer and jockey. Closed Saturday, July 16, 2016 with 18 Nominations. (Clear 83)

Bay Gelding, (Mg), by Indian Charlie - Ender's Sister by A.P. Indy. Trainer Arnaud Delacour. Bred by Green Lantern Stables, LLC (KY).

A. P. INDIAN came away in good order, tracked the pace while traveling comfortably, inched closer in the two path on the turn, made a bid outside the five-sixteenths, took the lead coming to the quarter-pole, was given one crack of a left-handed whip in upper stretch then quickly switched to a right-handed whip near the furlong marker, battled with the runner-up into the final sixteenth and proved best under strong handling. HOLY BOSS was forwardly placed on the outside, ranged up while three wide on the turn, made a bid outside the five-sixteenths, was asked at the quarter-pole, came under a drive in upper stretch, battled outside of the winner under a right-handed whip into the final sixteenth then was outfinished while clear for the place. CATALINA RED bumped with rivals on both sides at the start, was coaxed along while off the pace, raced in the two path while between horses on the turn, was put to stronger urging near the five-sixteenths, came under a right-handed whip at the quarter-pole, eased out a couple of paths in upper stretch, switched to a left-handed whip near the sixteenth-pole and finished willingly for the show while unable to impact the top two. DELTA BLUESMAN bumped with CATALINA RED at the start, showed good speed then set the pace, vied inside on the turn, was asked when confronted by the top two outside the five-sixteenths, lost the advantage coming to the quarter-pole, was put to a right-handed whip shortly thereafter, dropped back under a drive in upper stretch and weakened. ALL STAR RED angled in at the back of the field, reached the rail near the five-eighths pole, settled at the rear, was urged along while inside on the turn, came off the rail outside the quarter-pole, shifted three wide into the stretch, drifted in some at the three-sixteenths pole then was put to a right-handed whip and lacked the needed response. ANCHOR DOWN bumped with CATALINA RED while getting a tug of the left rein at the start, established position just off the pace while urged along, dropped back some while inside on the turn and tired. CHUBLICIOUS settled off the pace, went three wide while between horses on the turn, came under a right-handed whip in upper stretch and failed to respond. REQUITE settled on the outside, was urged along while four wide on the turn and failed to respond.
