ZENYATTA settled off the rail, moved up three deep on the backstretch and second turn, continued alongside the runner-up into the stretch, drifted in a bit while under left handed urging when taking the lead in midstretch, inched away in deep stretch and held on gamely. TOUGH TIZ'S SIS bobbed a bit at the start, chased inside then off the rail, angled back in leaving the second turn, was in a bit tight off heels when trying to split rivals in midstretch, came out and finished well. SILVER SWALLOW angled in and saved ground chasing the pace, came out leaving the second turn and into the stretch and finished with interest to best the others. SILVER Z sped to the early lead, opened a commanding advantage and set the pace inside, fought back along the rail in the stretch and weakened late. SEALY HILL chased outside a rival then between foes on the backstretch and second turn, was in a bit tight nearing the stretch and weakened. FLEETHEART three deep into and on the first turn, settled outside a rival on the backstretch and second turn and did not rally. ANDMOREAGAIN settled between horses then inside on the backstretch and second turn and was not a threat.
