AMERICAN GAL stumbled at the start and was bumped by NOBLE FREUD who recovered inwards from a bobble, took narrow command shortly after the start and vied four then three wide down the backstretch loosely between foes among a quartet stacked across the track, tucked to the two path into the turn and clung to the front now more tightly between rivals in hand until put to light coaxing near the five-sixteenths, swung three wide for home put to a drive, shook away the trio hounding her to draw clear through the stretch kept to task. VERTICAL OAK broke out at the start, vied from the six path early on until tucked four wide into the turn, the outermost of a guartet knocking heads through swift splits while in hand. came under coaxing five-sixteenths from home, swung five wide into upper stretch, proved no match for the top one while running on to win the battle for the place honors by a hard fought neck. NOBLE FREUD bobbled at the break recovering inwards and bumping with AMERICAN GAL. vied from the five path between foes loosely down the backstretch before tucking three wide into the turn, continued to spar with a trio through the bend put to a ride with five-sixteenths to go, cornered four wide into upper stretch, proved no match for the top one while fighting on head to head to the finish with the aforementioned foe, but was bested on the wire for the place honors while well clear for the show. GOLDEN MISCHIEF bumped at the start by TOO MUCH TIP who broke outwards then was bumped once more by AMERICAN GAL due to pressure from NOBLE FREUD, chased two to three wide settled in behind the pace disputing quartet on hold until put to encouragement at the five-sixteenths, angled out six wide into upper stretch and came up empty. TOO MUCH TIP a bit fractious in the gate prior to the start, broke out at the start bumping GOLDEN MISCHIEF, vied from the two path early on inside a trio until tucking to the rail nine-sixteenths out, came under coaxing seven-sixteenths from home continuing to battle on disputing the pace, got shaken off a bit nearing the quarter pole, spun just off the inside for home and tired.
