7 FURLONGS. (1.20²) STAKES. Purse \$70,000 VIC ZIEGEL MEMORIAL S. FOR THREE YEAR OLDS AND UPWARD FOALIED IN NEW YORK STATE AND APPROVED BY THE NEW YORK STATE BRED REGISTRY. No nomination fee. A supplemental nomination fee of \$200 may be made at time of entry. \$1,000 to enter. All starters will receive a \$750 rebate. The purse to be divided 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers. Three Year Olds, 121 lbs.; Older, 124 lbs. Non-winners of \$30,000 since July 1, 2010 allowed 2 lbs. \$35,000 twice in 2010 or such a race in 2010, 4 lbs.; three races in 2010 6 lbs. (Maiden, claiming, starter and restricted allowance races not considered). Preference by condition eligibility. Ties broken by total earnings. A presentation will be made to the winning owner. Nominations closed Saturday, August 21, 2010, with 15 nominations. (Clear 75)

Chestnut Gelding, (Apr), by Precise End - Afleet Closer by Afleet. Trainer Pletcher A. Todd. Bred by New Dawn Stud, LLC(NY).

DRIVEN BY SUCCESS set the pace under pressure, vied just off the rail on the turn, kicked clear when given his cue in upper stretch then drew off under one crack of a right-handed whip and strong hand urging. **GROOMEDFORVICTORY** moved up nearing the five-eighths pole, was rated just off the heels of the leader, dropped back a bit leaving the backstretch, moved out coming to the five-sixteenths pole, loomed briefly into the stretch, was quickly turned away and proved no match for the winner while second best. **NAUGHTY NEW YORKER** broke outward at the start then dropped back, was roused while three wide on the turn, battled with **UNCLE T SEVEN** for the show and secured that position. **UNCLE T SEVEN** brushed with a rival at the start, raced between horses early, moved up near the five-eighths pole, was urged a bit while off the rail on the turn, steadied when **GROOMEDFORVICTORY** came out near the five-sixteenths pole, was put to a drive shortly thereafter and came up empty then missed the show. **MAKE NOTE** bobbled slightly at the start then brushed with a rival, was urged along while on the outside, went four wide on the turn and tired. **ESTIMATOR** pressed the pace on the outside of the winner, drifted four wide into the stretch and faded.
