No nomination fee. \$1,000 to pass the entry box. A supplemental nomination fee of \$200 may be made at any point prior to entry. All starters including supplemental nominees to receive a \$750 rebate. The purse to be divided 60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. Three year olds, 121 lbs.; Older 12 4 lbs. Non-winners of a Sweepstakes since August 1 allowed 2 lbs.; three races, 4 lbs. (Maiden, claiming, and starter races not considered in allowances).
