HENNY HUGHES raced with the pace from the outside while well in hand, responded when shaken up in upper stretch, ran by pacesetter ATTILA'S STORM leaving the eighth pole and drew clear under a drive. WAR FRONT was urged along outside early, rallied three wide approaching the stretch, was no match for the winner in the drive but dug in to earn the place award. ATTILA'S STORM broke running, set the pace along the inside and weakened in the final furlong. WHO'S THE COWBOY was outrun along the inside early, came wide into the stretch and had no rally. SILVER TRAIN was outrun early, raced inside and had no response when roused.
