ROCK FALL broke in at the start squeezing back SALUTOS AMIGOS in tandem with STALLWALKIN' DUDE, ranged up to race three wide outside the top pair through the turn, came under coaxing nearing the quarter pole, swung three wide between foes into upper stretch, tussled with STALLWALKIN' DUDE through to the eighth pole heads apart for command, took a narrow advantage a sixteenth from home, dug in under challenge from a flanking trio through the late stages and held gamely to prevail. SALUTOS AMIGOS steadied when squeezed back at the start between foes each breaking his way, lost three to four lengths to the front, chased three wide from near the rear, came under encouragement midway on the turn, angled five wide into upper stretch, offered up a good finish closing with a rush the outermost of a quartet separated only a length strides from the wire and ran out of ground while procuring the place honors. STALLWALKIN' DUDE broke out at the start squeezing back SALUTOS AMIGOS in tandem with ROCK FALL, settled just off the pace just off the inside under rating early on, shifted three to four wide three furlongs out put to coaxing and advanced four wide through the latter portion of the turn moving swiftly into prominence stacked four wide outside a trio at the head of the stretch, took over command nearing the eighth pole under threat from ROCK FALL to the inside, dug in under a drive kicking on willingly, got headed a sixteenth out and battled on to the wire for the show honors. PALACE hustled from the gate, chased the pace along the inside in range, angled three to four wide into upper stretch set down for the drive, rallied into contention inside the final furlong, angled to the inside a sixteenth out and offered up late foot up the rail but could not impact the top trio on this day, settling for the last major share clear of the rest. WILDCAT RED hustled from the gate, established the front showing the way briefly while under pressure from WEEKEND HIDEAWAY to the outside, dueled through the turn with that rival as that foe got on even terms seven-sixteenths from home, came under coaxing under further threat nearing the quarter pole and the dueling pair got joined by an additional twosome to the outside, got headed cutting the corner into upper stretch, ran on inside through to the eighth pole before weakening in the late going. WEEKEND HIDEAWAY pressed the pace of WILDCAT RED early on before taking closer order to duel with that foe through the turn, came under coaxing five-sixteenths from home, spun just off the inside into upper stretch seizing brief command now between foes, yielded the front straightened away and weakened through the stretch. BROTHERSOFTHETIME lunged at the start getting away slowly, chased the front two to three wide near the rear detached from the main body of the field in tandem with SALUTOS AMIGOS early on, came under a ride three furlongs out, swung two to three wide for home and trailed.
