CAPTAIN BOMBASTIC away a bit slow, remained stationed along the inside route, steadily advanced into contentoin during the run

FIRST DEPUTY at a considerable distance from off the inside throughout, was towards the four path in pursuit of the front runners on the turn, was about as wide challenging in earnest at the
